Endorsements are placed on all pups sold and will only be lifted if the pup/dog has been bought on breeding terms and that a full vet health check is done at that the report is sent to myself or the kennel club to remove the endorsements. If a pet price has been paid then I will also expect the remainder to be paid for the breeding rights.

If Progeny not eligible for registration:

The Kennel Club will not register any puppies from this dog. However, it is very easy for me to lift this endorsement and I will happily do so *providing* you send me a copy of:

.....Certificate(s)

which shows a score not above the average. Any responsible breeder would not consider breeding without ensuring their animal is of sufficient quality. It is also necessary for this animal to still be owned by you.

If Not eligible for issue of export pedigree:

This does not stop you from taking your dog abroad. It stops the dog being registered with a foreign kennel club, therefore, making the puppy virtually worthless if bought on behalf of a buyer abroad. (Unfortunately this happens and breeders are horrified to discover their puppies have been sold on and sent to unsuitable countries). Once again, if you decide to live in another country, it is very easy for me to lift this endorsement.

If you would like either endorsement lifted, please contact me in good time.

The Kennel Club have requested that Accredited Breeders explain these two endorsements thoroughly, produce a written copy, and obtain your signature. I will, therefore, ask you to sign this declaration.

Purchaser to sign to state they fully understand the conditions of the endorsements which are made on this pup and to what I, the breeder, expect in order to lift the endorsements if requested.

A holding fee (deposit) is put into place so that the breeder will hold the pup until he/she is of an age to leave his/her mother. The holding fee works in 2 ways: 1 of which it secures your pup (so will not be sold to anyone else) and 2 so I the breeder know that puppy has his/her new family ready and waiting and has secured the sale.

The holding fee is non refundable on my part unless something was to come up in the pups vet health check which takes place at 6, 8 & 10 weeks (if still with me at 10 weeks).

In this I do not include small umbilical hernias for if it is very common within the breed of said pup. I do not reduce the price of the pup due to small umbilical hernias nor for pinched nostril syndrome.

Please do not place your holding fee if you are not sure, you must be 100% sure when placing your holding fee and signing our agreement as it is legally binding. I cannot be held responsible for any upset if you place the holding fee and then change your mind no matter what the time span or circumstances. *Please note: in exceptional circumstances, I might waver this agreement but this is at my a own discretion and I will not be pressured into doing so.*

Also if a holding fee has been placed and I hear nothing from the purchaser for 3 days after the collection date I have the right to re advertise the pup and no refund will be given.

Signature of purchaser:

I, the breeder, do reserve the right that if I was to feel I needed to pull out and end the sale of the pup/dog I can do so, especially if I was to feel it was in the best interests of the pup/dog. I would not do this without good reason and would be 100% upfront with you as to my reasons for doing so. You would of course then get your holding fee returned to you.

No pups will leave me before the day they are 8 weeks of age as this is a legal requirement but as the breeder, I reserve the right to keep the pup longer if I feel that he/she is not quite ready and at the milestone targets I would like them to be at. I will do my best as I do understand that you as the purchaser are excited and cannot wait to get your new pup/dog home, but the pup/dog is my main concern and I will not make it any longer than it has to be.

WHAT IS INCLUDED IN THE SALE

- Vet check (at weeks)
- Vaccinations (Y / N)
- Puppy health certificate copy from the vet
- Microchipped
- Regular worming (dates will be provided)
- KC papers (if stated registered)
- Puppy pack which includes:

- weeks free puppy insurance
- Life time of advice (if needed)
- A well socialised puppy with people and other dogs in my house
- Will have started on toilet training outside, weather permitting (if rubbish weather, will be puppy pad trained)

If the purchaser has a holiday around the time of collection I am more than happy to keep the pup for an extended time but I do expect full payment of the puppy/dog at the time he/she will have been ready to leave, which is generally at 8 weeks. I want to be informed as soon as possible about the holiday so preparations can be made.

The purchaser has also been shown a copy of the contract.
